**Announcements:**

\* HOLYDAY OF OBLIGATION: Tomorrow is the feast of All Saints. Please note the Mass times. There is also a 5:00 pm Mass at Mount Saint Michael for those who may need to attend an evening Mass.

\* **FEAST OF CHRIST THE KING** is today. There will be benediction after the 9:00 am Mass, with Act of Consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Let us especially renew the consecration of our homes and families to the Sacred Heart of Christ our King on this feast. We also encourage the practice of Night Adoration in the Home. If you wish to participate, please sign up on the list in the vestibule. Booklets for adoration are free for those who sign up.

\* **ALL SOULS DAY:** The special Toties Quoties indulgence begins tomorrow at Noon and may be gained as often as you wish until midnight on Tuesday. Those unable to obtain it between Noon tomorrow and midnight on Tuesday may gain it between Noon next Saturday and midnight next Sunday. There is also a plenary indulgence that may be gained once each day during the Octave of All Souls Day by devoutly visiting the cemetery and praying for the Poor Souls.

\* **FALL BACK:** Daily Savings Time ends next Sunday morning. Be sure to turn your clocks back one hour Saturday night.

\* **NEW STAINED GLASS WINDOWS:** Installation of the aluminum vents and insulated glass will take place in December, followed by the stained glass in January. The remaining balance for these windows is \$106,254.89. Those who make a significant contribution will have their names listed on a plaque in the vestibule.

\* **APOLOGETICS CLASS:** There will be a class this Thursday at 7:00 pm in the seminary classroom.
