

WELCOME NEWCOMERS!

If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in the church. Since the changes in the Church, few parishes have any kind of dress code. Here, however, we still believe that modesty and appropriate attire are necessary, especially in Church out of reverence for the Blessed Sacrament. Please observe these minimum standards of dress for attendance at Church services:

- Women and girls must cover their heads. Chapel veils or mantillas are available for loan in the vestibule. They should also wear dresses or skirts that cover the knee completely when standing or sitting; slacks, shorts, sleeveless, tight, or low-cut clothing are not permitted.
- Men and boys should wear a suit coat and tie
- Jeans and other casual attire are inappropriate for attendance at Church services.
- Also, unless you have been attending the Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you have had an opportunity to meet with Father.

Our Lady of La Salette

The parish of La Salette in the diocese of Grenoble comprises a few tiny hamlets in the French Alps...It was the scene of an apparition of Our Lady to two rude cattle herders, Melanie Mathieu, aged 14, and Maximin Giraud, Aged 11. This took place on Saturday afternoon, September 19, 1846...As they watched, the splendor of the light intensified, dazzlingly. They were puzzled and fear-stricken and were about to flee when they observed that the luminous circle was opening. Gradually they could make out...the figure of a woman. She was seated, her face in her hands, in an attitude of sorrow, weeping. Slowly, with unearthly grace she arose with her arms crossed on her breast and her head somewhat inclined, she confronted them. As they gazed in fascination, the children head the woman speak in a voice both commanding and reassuring. "Come to me, my children. Do not be afraid. I am here to tell you something of the greatest importance" ... "If my people will not obey, I shall be compelled to loose my Son's arm. It is so heavy, so pressing that I can no longer restrain it. How long I have suffered for you! If my Son is not to cast you off, I am obliged to entreat Him without ceasing. But you take no least notice of that. No matter how well you pray in future, no matter how well you act, you will never be able to make up to me what I have endured for your sake." ... "I have appointed you six days for working. The seventh I have reserved for myself. And no one will give it to me. This it is which causes the weight of my Son's arm to be so crushing." ... "The cart drivers cannot swear without bringing in my Son's name. These are the two things which make my Son's arm so burdensome."
