

WELCOME NEWCOMERS!

If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in the church. Since the changes in the Church, few parishes have any kind of dress code. Here, however, we still believe that modesty and appropriate attire are necessary, especially in Church out of reverence for the Blessed Sacrament. Please observe these minimum standards of dress for attendance at Church services:

- Women and girls must cover their heads. Chapel veils or mantillas are available for loan in the vestibule. They should also wear dresses or skirts that cover the knee completely when standing or sitting; slacks, shorts, sleeveless, tight, or low-cut clothing are not permitted.
- Men and boys should wear a suit coat and tie.
- Jeans and other casual attire are inappropriate for attendance at Church services.
- Also, unless you have been attending the Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you have had an opportunity to meet with Father.

OUR LADY OF LOURDES

The first of the eighteen apparitions of the Blessed Virgin Mary to the Blessed Virgin Mary to the humble Bernadette took place at Lourdes on February 11, 1858. On March 25th, when Bernadette asked the Beautiful Lady her name, she replied: “I am the Immaculate Conception.” The last took place on 16 July, of the same year. Bernadette often fell into an ecstasy. The mysterious vision she saw in the hollow of the rock Massabielle was that of a young and beautiful lady. “Lovelier than I have ever seen,” said the child. But the girl was the only one who saw the vision, although sometimes many stood there with her. Now and then the apparition spoke to the seer who also was the only one who heard the voice. Thus, she one day told her to drink from a mysterious fountain, in the grotto itself, the existence of which was unknown, and of which there was no sign, but which immediately gushed forth. On another occasion the apparition bade Bernadette go and tell the priests she wished a chapel to be built on the spot and processions to be made to the grotto. At first the clergy were incredulous. It was only four years later, in 1862, that the bishop of the diocese declared the faithful “justified in believing the reality of the apparition”.

ASH WEDNESDAY: This Wednesday begins the holy season of Lent. Blessed Ashes will be distributed after the 7:00 am Mass and at 10:30. This Wednesday is also a day of total abstinence. Meat is not permitted at all on Wednesday.

SEASON OF LENT: The season of Lent is a time for penance and prayer, especially meditation on the Passion of Our Lord. Let us all be sure to perform penance during this season, when special graces are available to us.

LENTEN FASTING: The Church law on Fasting requires all adults, aged 21-59 to fast every day of Lent, except Sundays, unless excused from this law for health reasons. Fasting means that only one full meal is allowed, which may contain meat, unless it is a day of total abstinence. There is no eating between

meals. Two small meatless meals may be taken which if combined would not equal or exceed the amount of food taken at a normal main meal.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS are recited every Friday of Lent at 11:00 am (10:20 am on First Friday)

EUCCHARISTIC VIGIL for Vocations will be held this Saturday, from 9:00 am – 3:00 pm. Please use the sign-up sheet in the vestibule if you would like to participate.

CONFRATERNITY OF MIQ: There will be a meeting this Saturday, following the 8:00 am Mass.
