

WELCOME NEWCOMERS!

If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in the church. Since the changes in the Church, few parishes have any kind of dress code. Here, however, we still believe that modesty and appropriate attire are necessary, especially in Church out of reverence for the Blessed Sacrament. Please observe these minimum standards of dress for attendance at Church services:

- Women and girls must cover their heads. Chapel veils or mantillas are available for loan in the vestibule. They should also wear dresses or skirts that cover the knee completely when standing or sitting; slacks, shorts, sleeveless, tight, or low-cut clothing are not permitted.
- Men and boys should wear a suit coat and tie.
- Jeans and other casual attire are inappropriate for attendance at Church services.
- Also, unless you have been attending the Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you have had an opportunity to meet with Father.

We are always happy to see new faces at Mary Immaculate Queen Church, and we look forward to seeing you again.

**ST. ROBERT BELLARMINE, Bishop
Confessor & Doctor of the Church**

Born at Montepulciano, Italy, October 4, 1542, St. Robert Bellarmine was the third of ten children...One day Robert was kneeling in church with his mother. He was attracted by a mural depicting a saint dressed in a cardinal's robes, and whispered to his mother, "Look mother I have become a cardinal!" His mother tried to keep the young boy quiet but he then pointed to another mural depicting the four principal Doctors of the Church, and added prophetically, "...Some day I too will be numbered as one of them." This prophecy, like so many others of St. Bellarmine, after three centuries, was finally verified.

He joined the Society of Jesus and was later made Cardinal and Archbishop of Capua. He was famous throughout Europe as a theologian and as a strenuous defender of the Faith. His numerous writings include works of devotion and instruction, as well as of controversy. He died in 1621.

**OUR LADY OF THE BLESSED

The faithful who during the month of May take part in public exercises in honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary may gain:

An indulgence of 7 years on any day of the month; A plenary indulgence if they assist at the exercises on at least ten days, and moreover go to confession, receive Holy Communion and pray for the intentions of Holy Mother Church.

Those who perform their devotions privately during the aforesaid month are granted:

An indulgence of 5 years once on any day of the month. A plenary indulgence on the usual conditions, if they perform these devotions every day during the month; but where public exercises are held, this indulgence is granted only to those who are lawfully hindered from taking part in the same.
