If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in the church. Since the changes in the Church, few parishes have any kind of dress code. Here, however, we still believe that modesty and appropriate attire are necessary, especially in Church out of reverence for the Blessed Sacrament. Please observe these minimum standards of dress for attendance at Church services:

- Women and girls must cover their heads. Chapel veils or mantillas are available for loan in the vestibule. They should also
 wear dresses or skirts that cover the knee completely when standing or sitting; slacks, shorts, sleeveless, tight, or low-cut
 clothing are not permitted.
- Men and boys should wear a suit coat and tie.
- Jeans and other casual attire are inappropriate for attendance at Church services.
- Also, unless you have been attending the Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you
 have had an opportunity to meet with Father.

THE LITANY OF SAINTS RACCOLTA #687

- A. The faithful who on the feast of St. Mark the Evangelist or on the Rogation days devoutly assist at the sacred ceremony proper to these days in churches or in public oratories are granted: An indulgence of 10 years; A plenary indulgence if they have obtained the forgiveness of their sins, received Holy Communion and prayed for the intentions of Holy Mother Church.
- B. Those, however, who on the aforementioned days when the sacred function mentioned above does not take place, recite the Litany of the Saints, are granted: *An indulgence of 7 years*.
- C. Those who on other days of the year piously recite the same Litany are granted: An indulgence of t years; a plenary indulgence on the usual conditions, if they recite the same Litany daily for an entire month.

ORIGIN OF THE ROGATION-DAYS

The origin of the Rogation-Days, or the three days of prayer and abstinence immediately preceding the Feast of the Ascension, may be traced to St. Mamertus...in the 5th century. From the time that the Burgundians invaded this country, it had been visited every year with grievous calamities, which were looked upon as chastisements from God. The year 470 was a terribly fatal one to the city of Vienne; and the holy bishop then made a vow to establish rogations, or public prayers and processions, in his diocese every year. The people gladly cooperated with him, and he then appointed the ceremonies for the three days before the Ascension, prescribed a fast to be observed, and chose three churches outside of the walls of the town as places to which the processions should be made. The prayers were answered, the scourge was removed, and the other French bishops adopted the same plan in their respective dioceses. Toward the end of the eighth century, Pope Leo III imposed the observance of the Rogations-Days as an obligation on the whole Latin Church: In consideration of the Paschal season, the fast is no longer required.


