

WELCOME NEWCOMERS!

If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in the church. Since the changes in the Church, few parishes have any kind of dress code. Here, however, we still believe that modesty and appropriate attire are necessary, especially in Church out of reverence for the Blessed Sacrament. Please observe these minimum standards of dress for attendance at Church services:

- Women and girls must cover their heads. Chapel veils or mantillas are available for loan in the vestibule. They should also wear dresses or skirts that cover the knee completely when standing or sitting; slacks, shorts, sleeveless, tight, or low-cut clothing are not permitted.
- Men and boys should wear a suit coat and tie.
- Jeans and other casual attire are inappropriate for attendance at Church services.
- Also, unless you have been attending the Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you have had an opportunity to meet with Father.

MONTH OF THE PRECIOUS BLOOD: During July there will be daily devotions in honor of the Most Precious Blood of Jesus after Mass.

FIRST FRIDAY: There will be devotions to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus and Benediction after Mass on Friday.

JULY 4TH of this year, although a Friday, is not a day of abstinence. However, the faithful are exhorted to practice other works of piety by way of compensation.

PRIESTS’ TRAVELS: Father Martin has Mass in Calgary, Alberta, today.

CHURCH SEATING: On Sundays, please leave the last three pews on each side of the church for families with small children. We encourage those who do not have small children to move up toward the middle or front of the church, rather than crowding the back of the church.

MASS STIPENDS: Please observe the following points regarding Mass stipends.

- ✠ Mass requests are offered in the order received.
- ✠ Stipends are limited to two Mass requests per month, per household
- ✠ Customary stipend is \$25. (Checks payable to Marian Fathers.)
- ✠ We are not able to accept stipends for specific dates.
- ✠ Gregorian Masses are offered only for deceased parishioners (\$800 stipend).

CHURCH DECORUM: Please be sure to:

- ✠ Turn cell phones off while in church!
- ✠ Avoid leaving the church during Sunday Mass, outside of grave necessity.
- ✠ If there is an urgent need to leave the church during Mass, do not use the front right exit.
- ✠ Wait until the priest leaves the sanctuary after Mass before exiting the church.
