If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in the church. Since the changes in the Church, few parishes have any kind of dress code. Here, however, we still believe that modesty and appropriate attire are necessary, especially in Church out of reverence for the Blessed Sacrament. Please observe these minimum standards of dress for attendance at Church services:

- Women and girls must cover their heads. Chapel veils or mantillas are available for loan in the vestibule. They should also wear dresses or skirts that cover the knee completely when standing or sitting; slacks, shorts, sleeveless, tight, or low-cut clothing are not permitted.
 - Men and boys should wear a suit coat and tie.
 - Jeans and other casual attire are inappropriate for attendance at Church services.
 - Also, unless you have been attending the Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you have had an opportunity to meet with Father.
- We are always happy to see new faces at Mary Immaculate Queen Church, and we look forward to seeing you again.

NORTH AMERICAN MARTYRS

Saints Isaac Jogues, John de Brebeuf, Charles Garnier, Anthony Daniel, Gabriel Lallemand, Noel Chabanel, John de Lalande and Rene Goupil, French Jesuits, were among the missionaries who preached the Gospel to Huron and Iroquois Indians in the United States and Canada. Pope Pius XI beatified them on June 21, 1925, and in 1930 they were canonized by the same Pope.

St. Isaac Jogues, in particular, is outstanding because after spending thirteen months in slavery and being rescued by the Dutch, he returned after two years to Canada, and in 1646 visited Auriesville, New York, to negotiate peace with the Iroquois. He is said to be the first Catholic priest to set foot on Manhattan Island. After a third visit to the Iroquois he was seized, tortured and beheaded. Lives of the Saints, Page 377

OUR LADY OF RANSOM

The feast of Our Lady of Ransom, or Our Lady of Mercy commemorates on September 24th the foundation of the Order of Our Lady of Mercy in 1218 by St. Peter Nolasco, in Barcelona, Spain. Certain noblemen of that city had formed a confraternity for the purpose of caring for the sick and poor in the hospitals, and also for rescuing Christian captives from the Moors.

St. Peter Nolasco and St. Raymond Pennafort turned the confraternity into a religious Order, of which the noblemen of the confraternity were the first members. The Order was approved, first by Honorius III and then by Gregory IX (1230). St. Peter Nolasco was the first superior. The spread of the Order was almost immediate. Convents of Mercy were established in France, England, Germany, Portugal and other countries. Convents of nuns of the Order of Mercy were established; the female tertiaries of the Order go back to 1265. The nuns of the Order began their history at Seville in 1568 with Blessed Anne of the Cross as their first superioress.

September 24th is now the patronal feast day of the Sisters of Mercy, as well as of a number of other religious communities of men and women dedicated to the service of God under the patronage of Our Lady of Mercy. Lives of the Saints, pages 374-375
