

WELCOME NEWCOMERS!

If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in the church. Since the changes in the Church, few parishes have any kind of dress code. Here, however, we still believe that modesty and appropriate attire are necessary, especially in Church out of reverence for the Blessed Sacrament. Please observe these minimum standards of dress for attendance at Church services:

- Women and girls must cover their heads. Chapel veils or mantillas are available for loan in the vestibule. They should also wear dresses or skirts that cover the knee completely when standing or sitting; slacks, shorts, sleeveless, tight, or low-cut clothing are not permitted.
- Men and boys should wear a suit coat and tie.
- Jeans and other casual attire are inappropriate for attendance at Church services.
- Also, unless you have been attending the Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you have had an opportunity to meet with Father.

We are always happy to see new faces at Mary Immaculate Queen Church, and we look forward to seeing you again.

SAINT GERARD MAJELLA, C
October 16

St. Gerard became the most famous wonderworker of the eighteenth century. Of his childhood his mother testified: “His only happiness was in the church, on his knees before the Blessed Sacrament. In the house he prayed all day. He was born for heaven.” ...After attending a mission given by Redemptorist Fathers he asked to be admitted to their Order. He was given the habit and during the novitiate worked so hard and was so self-effacing as a sacristan and gardener that some said: “He is a fool or a saint.” For the three remaining years after his profession, he was kept busy as tailor and infirmarian, begging for the community, and accompanying the Fathers on their missions. Here he proved of great help, for he had the gift of reading souls and brought many sinners to repentance. He also displayed other supernatural gifts: ecstatic flight through the air, bilocation, a mysterious power over animals and nature, prophecy, and infused knowledge...St. Gerard showed great love for the poor and afflicted. He not only worked many miracles of healing for them but produced food and clothing from sources known only to him.
