If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in the church. Since the changes in the Church, few parishes have any kind of dress code. Here, however, we still believe that modesty and appropriate attire are necessary, especially in Church out of reverence for the Blessed Sacrament. Please observe these minimum standards of dress for attendance at Church services:

- Women and girls must cover their heads. Chapel veils or mantillas are available for loan in the vestibule. They should also wear dresses or skirts that cover the knee completely when standing or sitting; slacks, shorts, sleeveless, tight, or low-cut clothing are not permitted.
- Men and boys should wear a suit coat and tie.
- Jeans and other casual attire are inappropriate for attendance at Church services.
- Also, unless you have been attending the Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you
 have had an opportunity to meet with Father.

We are always happy to see new faces at Mary Immaculate Queen Church, and we look forward to seeing you again.

AN ACT OF ACCEPTING ONE'S OWN DEATH FROM THE HAND OF GOD – Raccolta #639

The faithful who at any time in their lives, from a sincere spirit of love of God and with at least a contrite heart, express their intention of accepting calmly and gladly from the hand of God whatsoever manner of death it may please Him to send them, together with all its pain, anguish and suffering, may gain:

An indulgence of 7 years;

A plenary indulgence at the hour of death, if they have devoutly made such an act at least once in their lifetime, after having fulfilled the usual conditions.

Act of Resignation to One's Death

St. Francis de Sales says that to wish to do the Will of God is of unspeakable merit.

He lays down the following teaching, which must fill the coldest heart with comfort. He says that if an ordinary Christian learns from the priest or the doctor that he is dying, and that if he accepts death with resignation because it is God's Will, he may go straight to Heaven. Why? Because death is the penalty God gave us for sin. It is the greatest of all penalties, the destruction of our life, the rending apart of the body from the soul—and at the same time it is the holiest and most meritorious of all penances.

Pope Pius X seems to have had this teaching in mind when he granted a plenary indulgence at the hour of death to those who say, on some day after receiving Communion, this short prayer: "O my God, from this moment forward I accept with a joyful and resigned heart the death You will be pleased to send me, with all its pains, sufferings and anguish."

Though the Holy Father grants a plenary indulgence if this prayer be said **once**, still it is advisable to say it after **every** Holy Communion. It takes only a moment and is of great merit.

Neither should we be satisfied with saying the words: "Thy will be done" only when we say the Our Father; we should do well to say them as an ejaculatory prayer very often in the course of the day.

We should wish to do the Will of God in everything we do. It would be madness not to do so, because God's Will is the very best thing for us. This we have already said when treating of the Our Father, but we can never impress it too deeply on our hearts.


