

**WELCOME NEWCOMERS!**

If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in the church. Since the changes in the Church, few parishes have any kind of dress code. Here, however, we still believe that modesty and appropriate attire are necessary, especially in Church out of reverence for the Blessed Sacrament. Please observe these minimum standards of dress for attendance at Church services:

- Women and girls must cover their heads. Chapel veils or mantillas are available for loan in the vestibule. They should also wear dresses or skirts that cover the knee completely when standing or sitting; slacks, shorts, sleeveless, tight, or low-cut clothing are not permitted.
- Men and boys should wear a suit coat and tie.
- Jeans and other casual attire are inappropriate for attendance at Church services.
- Also, unless you have been attending the Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you have had an opportunity to meet with Father.

We are always happy to see new faces at Mary Immaculate Queen Church, and we look forward to seeing you again.

O Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, have mercy on us!

*An indulgence of 300 days,*

**RACCOLTA # 136**

Praise and adoration ever more be given to the most holy Sacrament. *An indulgence of 300 days. A plenary indulgence on the usual conditions once a month for its daily and devout repetition.*

**RACCOLTA #136**

O Sacrament most holy, O Sacrament divine! All praise and all thanksgiving be every moment Thine. *An indulgence of 300 days. An indulgence of 3 years, when this ejaculation is recited in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament. A plenary indulgence on the usual conditions, if the daily recitation of this ejaculation is continued for a whole month.*

**RACCOLTA #139**

Blessed is He that cometh in the name of the Lord; Hosanna in the highest. *The faithful, who devoutly recite this prayer after the consecration in the Mass, are granted: An indulgence of 500 days: A plenary indulgence once a month on the usual conditions, if they recite it daily.*

**RACCOLTA # 146**

a) *The faithful who pay the homage of a due genuflection before the Blessed Sacrament reserved in the tabernacle, at the same time reciting the following or similar ejaculation: Jesus, My God, I adore Thee here present in the Sacrament of Thy love! may gain: An indulgence of 300 days.*

b) *If they duly genuflect on both knees before the Blessed Sacrament solemnly exposed to the adoration of the faithful, reciting the above-mentioned prayer, or one like it: An indulgence of 500 days.*

c) *If they make some outward sign of reverence when passing a church or oratory where the Blessed Sacrament is reserved: An indulgence of 300 days.*
